Bush, and awarded the Presidential Medal of Freedom. He is the author of six bestselling books, a syndicated columnist and former FOX News contributor.

Lauren Cooley is a graduate of Furman University, where she earned a B.A. in Political Science and ran the Conservative Students for a Better Tomorrow – a group


